



## Notice of Intent to Award

In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, bids were received for the above-referenced project at City Hall on Thursday, December 7, 2021. Two construction firms submitted bids for this project. The results of the bids were as follows:

Note this firm was pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.

Magnolia proposes a MBE participation of 15% and a WBE of 2.6%. This project will have a participation of 17.6%, exceeding the project goal established for this project of 15%.

Magnolia Underground will perform 72% of the work, subcontracting out 15% to W&T Contracting and 13% to Fosset Paving.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on Magnolia Undergrounds bid documents, and their bid has been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the project's terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to Magnolia Underground. If you concur with the Program Team's recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

The Program Team will start tentative negotiations with Magnolia Underground in the meantime, and upon the City's approval, we will move into formal negotiations to get the contract completed and a Notice to Proceed issued.
