Black & Veatch and Overland Contracting (a subsidiary of Black & Veatch), as the Program Manager and Construction Manager for the Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program (SARP10) on behalf of the City of Memphis, is soliciting Request for Bid (RFB) for the **Barksdale Siphon & Sewer Improvements** Scope of Work.

**Scope of Work:**

The scope of the work for this project consists of installing ±1,100 feet of new polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe of varying diameters (8-inch to 30-inch), and ±150 feet a new double barrel HDPE pipe sewer siphon. Other related work includes installation new precast manholes, flow diversion structures, reconnecting existing services, traffic control, erosion control, post construction pipe & manhole assessment, and bypass pumping.

**Registration:**

Firms not already prequalified for construction activity with SARP10 and Firms that prequalified more than one year ago, must submit the following registration information as soon as possible; but no later than **March 2, 2018**. SARP10 registration is valid for one year from the date of approval and will apply for all related construction contracts, under the SARP10 Program. If the Firm has prequalified with SARP10 in the past year, the Firm is not obligated to reapply.
