Black & Veatch and Overland Contracting (a subsidiary of Black & Veatch), as the Program Manager and Construction Manager for the Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program (SARP10) on behalf of the City of Memphis, is soliciting Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Front Street Interceptor Cleaning.

The intent of the RFP is to obtain proposals for the removal and disposal of solids and sludge from the Front Street Interceptor. The cleaning shall occur from the manhole at the intersection of Poplar Avenue and Front Street, to the manhole in Front Street immediately upstream of the Gayoso Pumping Station (approximately 4,000 feet). Other related work includes, but is not limited to, site preparation and restoration, traffic control, permitting, and grease cap removal.

Registration:

Firms not already prequalified with SARP10 and Firms that prequalified more than one year ago, must submit the following registration information as soon as possible; but no later than January 30, 2019. SARP10 registration is valid for one year from the date of approval and will apply for all related contracts, under the SARP10 Program. If the Firm has prequalified with SARP10 in the past year, the Firm is not obligated to reapply.

- Step Two: A Black & Veatch Sourcing Specialist will send a separate email requesting additional information for review and approval by Black & Veatch / OCI.

*No proposals will be accepted from any Firm who has not successfully completed the registration process and met the minimal qualification standards.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be held at 9:00 AM (local time) at Benjamin Hooks Central Library 3030 Poplar Avenue Memphis, TN 38111, on January 10, 2019. Bidders are required to attend at their own cost.

Proposals:

Proposals will be received at the SARP10 Program Office, 845 Crossover Lane, Suite 120, Memphis, TN 38117, until 3:00 P.M. (local time), February 26, 2019. Late proposals will be rejected and will not be considered for award. Additional instructions for submitting the proposals are included in the RFP.
