In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, bids were received for the above-referenced project at City Hall through Tuesday, March 22, 2016. Two construction firms submitted bids for this project. The results of the bids were as follows:

1. Insituform Technologies, LLC

2. SAK Construction, LLC

\$2,781,845.00 (low bidder) \$3,779,975.00

Note that all firms were pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.

Insituform Technologies proposes a M/WBE participation of 10.6%.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on Institutorm Technologies' bid documents, and their bid has been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the projects terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to Insituform Technologies. If you concur with the Program Team's recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

The Program Team will start tentative negotiations with Insituform Technologies in the meantime, and upon the City's approval, we will move into formal negotiations to get the contract completed and a Notice to Proceed issued.
