Additional Bidder Questions

Q1: Nowhere in the RFP are the methods, the performance criteria, or the deliverables described for “cleaning and assessing 12” and smaller diameter siphons”. All past siphon work has been paid at an hourly crew rate by SARP. Now the SARP team is requesting a “per-foot unit price” for this task. To allow for direct comparison of price submittals, is it possible for SARP to elaborate in more detail on the final acceptance criteria for this task, as well as on the expected average level of effort (hours?) required for a siphon line to be classed as UTC (unable to complete) due to site conditions?

SARP10: The Contractor shall be responsible for cleaning and assessing 12-inch and smaller diameter siphons to the same criteria as gravity mains. See Specification 00003 “Close Circuit Television Inspection of Sewer Mains & Connections” Section 3.01 “CCTV Inspection of Sewer Mains.” Note, Section 3.01.A.3.e states that “Siphons shall be cleaned to remove 95% of the debris in the pipe,” but all other criteria remains the same as gravity mains.

Q2: Over the past Phase 2 and 3 projects, the City has added “Paving Projects” to some contracts for completion. Have the completed footages for these “Paving Projects” (MACP, PACP, Smoke) been deducted from the bid inventories for each of the Phase 4 project areas?

SARP10: The completed footages for the Paving Projects have not been deducted from the bid quantities. They are listed below. The Contractor shall be responsible for identifying lines and manholes previously assessed and labeled as “Field Verified,” and will not be compensated for re-inspecting the assets.
