In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, bids were received for the above-referenced project at City Hall through Thursday, May 14, 2015. Three construction firms submitted bids for this project. The results of the bids were as follows:

Note that all three firms were pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.


W&T Contracting is on the City's EBO list, so all of the work counts toward the M/WBE goal.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on W&T Contracting's bid documents, and their bid has been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the projects terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to W&T Contracting. If you concur with the Program Team's recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

The Program Team will start tentative negotiations with W&T Contracting in the meantime, and upon the expiration of the bid protest period (10 calendar days following the City posting the Bid Tabulation onto the Program Website), and the City's approval, we will move into formal negotiations to get the contract completed and a Notice to Proceed issued.
