In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, bids were received for the above-referenced project at the SARP10 office on Thursday, September 3, 2020. Two construction firms submitted bids for this project. The results of the bids were as follows:

Note that all firms were pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.

W & T Contracting is an MBE firm and proposes to perform 50% of the work, exceeding the project MBE goal of 13% established for this project. W & T Contracting proposes a WBE participation of 2%, meeting the project goal of 2% established for this project.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on W & T Contracting's bid documents, and their bid has been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the project's terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to W & T Contracting. If you concur with the Program Team's recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

The Program Team will start tentative negotiations with W & T Contracting in the meantime, and upon the City's approval, we will move into formal negotiations to get the contract completed and a Notice to Proceed issued.
