In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, proposals were received for the above-referenced project at SARP10 office on Thursday, February 26, 2019. One firm submitted proposals for this project. The results of the bid were as follows:

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| 1. Compliance EnviroSystem (CES) | \$4,915,672.54 (low bidder) |
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Note that the firm was pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.

CES proposes a M/WBE participation of 7.73%, with all 7.73% going to Cambridge Construction Management, Inc, exceeding the project goal established for this project of 5%.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on CES's proposal documents, and their proposal has been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the project's terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to CES. If you concur with the Program Team's recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

The Program Team will start tentative negotiations with CES in the meantime, and upon the City's approval, we will move into formal negotiations to get the contract completed and a Notice to Proceed issued.
