In conjunction with the City's Consent Decree Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program, bids were received for the above referenced project at City Hall on April 22, 2025. Four construction contractors submitted a bid for this project and the result are as follows:

1. Acuff Enterprises	\$3,349,898.00
2. Argo Construction	\$2,736,597.80
3. Magnolia Underground Construction	\$2,911,950.00
4. W&T Contracting Corporation	\$2,443,872.44 (Low Bidder)

All contractors were pre-qualified and approved to compete for this work.

W&T Contracting is an MWBE therefore the participation goal would be 100%.

Subsequent due diligence has been conducted on W&T Contracting's bid documents and have been found to be responsive, in order, and compliant with the projects scope of work and terms and conditions.

It is therefore our recommendation that this contract be awarded to W&T Contracting Corporation. If you concur with the Program Teams recommendation, please confirm the City's approval.

In the meantime, the Program Team will start the tentative negotiations with W&T Contracting Corporation. Upon the City's approval, we will move to finalize and execute the Contract for issuance of a Notice to Proceed.
